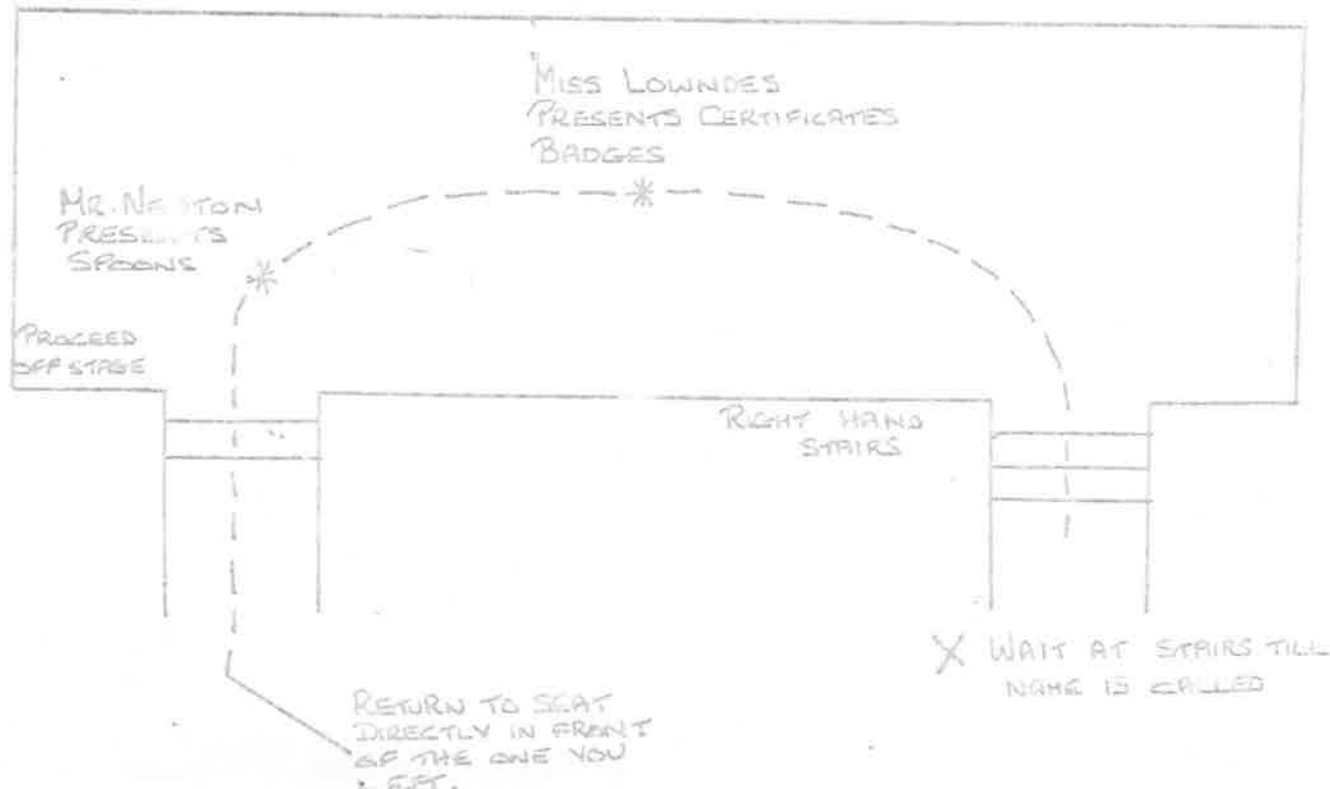

When Miss Carter-Brown is asked to present the graduates Sr. Alps will stand and walk to the bottom of the stairs at the right of the stage then wait until her name is called. As soon as the name of the graduate is called the next graduate (refer to graduation programme available on the night) will walk to bottom of the steps and wait till her/his name is called. Proceed across the stage thus:



When graduates leave stage proceed to the seat directly in front of the one you left.

Prize winners will be called and walk from their seats to the stage and cross the stage in the same manner as the graduates.

Mr. Newton will invite the nurse aides then the general graduates to recite the pledge.

Graduate on the right hand side will use right hand stairs go to Miss Ashbury and receive a candle, students on left hand side will go to Miss Harrison and receive a candle.

Nursing aides stand on elevated platform and recite pledge.

General nurse graduates follow same routine as nursing aides but stand in front of nursing aides to recite pledge.

When general nurses complete pledge with candles still lit leave stage by the same stair - form pairs and leave hall by centre aisle.

Graduates and prize winners must be at the hall at 6-00 p.m. on the 10th August, 1977 so that a rehearsal of the procedure can be carried out. Facilities for changing into uniform following the rehearsal have been arranged.

Miss Day, Miss Brown ushers for graduates to leave seats and stand at bottom of stairs.
