

# SHADOWLESS LIGHT FOR GOS. HOSPITAL

A new shadowless light, valued at £450 has been installed in the operating theatre at Gosford District Hospital.

The shadowless light gives surgeons high intensity illumination for all operations.

It is part of the equipment which was purchased with a special grant from the Hospitals Commission.

The commission has also made £175 available for the purchase of an ice-cooled oxygen tent for use at the hospital.

The alterations on the ground floor of the hospital to provide an extra pan-room are almost completed.

When in use, the extra room will serve for facilities for the female ward, and the children's ward.

## EXTRA CAR

The board will purchase an extra car for use by the additional district nurse who is to be appointed for the Woy Woy area.

Additional furniture for the office is now required with the increase in staff, and the board is applying to the commission for permission to purchase some.

Permission is also being sought to replace guttering on some of the existing hospital buildings.
